Since 2009, Iowa's residential energy code has saved:

Consumer Energy Bill Savings
\$47,008,318

Total Energy Savings (MMBTU)
3,580,493

Total CO₂e Savings (Tons)
281,252

That's enough to:

Pay for **1,218** students to attend 4 years of college

Powering **29,699** homes

Build **362** miles of new bike lanes



Installing **71** new wind turbines

Buy **672** Tesla Model S electric cars



Removing **59,410** cars from the road
