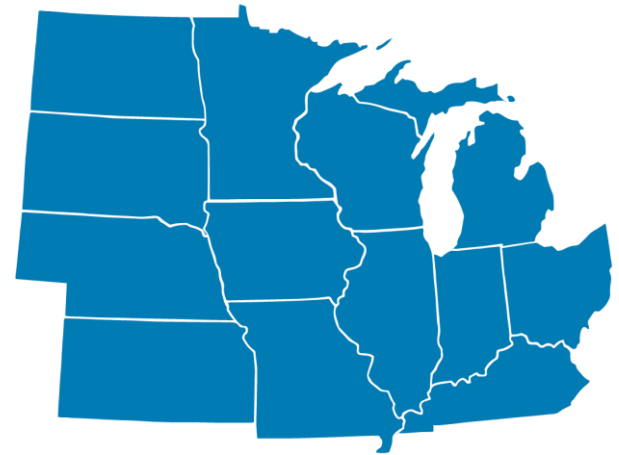

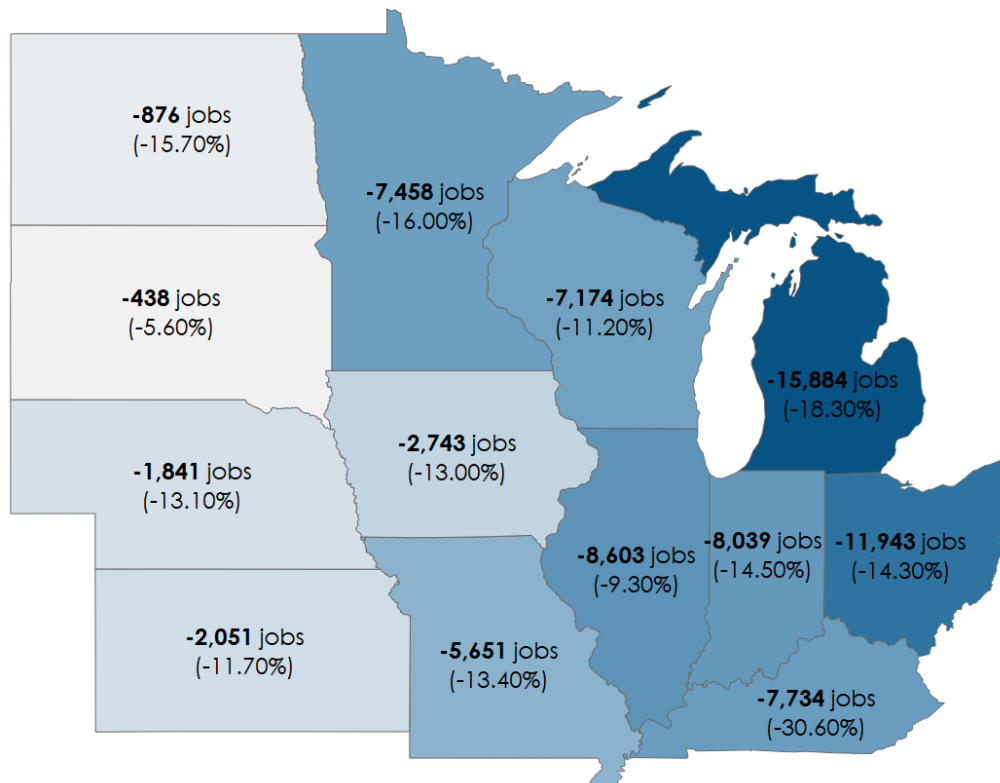
COVID-19

- Implementation of social distancing guidelines and reduction of on-site visits
- Energy code effective dates postponed in some states/municipalities

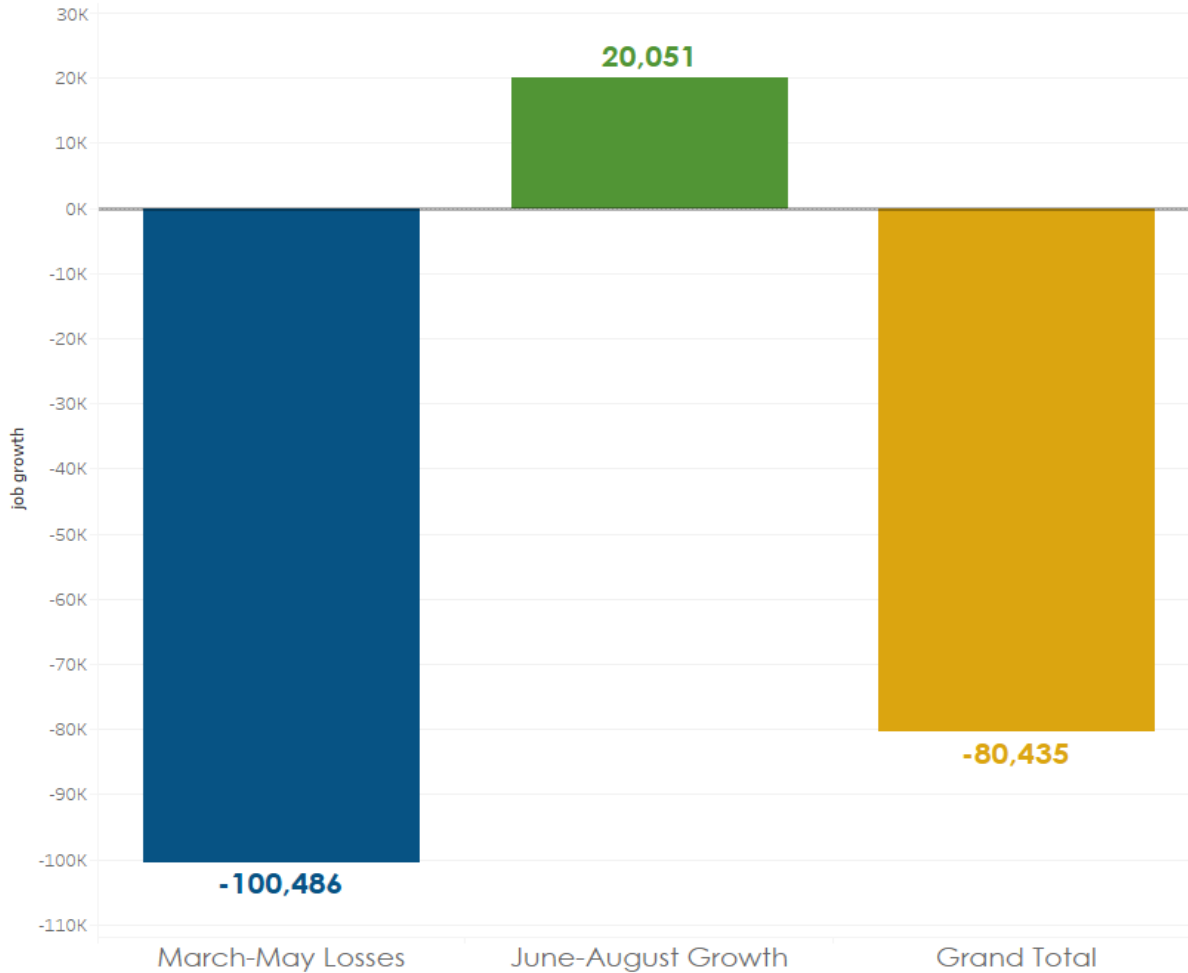
Midwest EE Jobs Lost During COVID

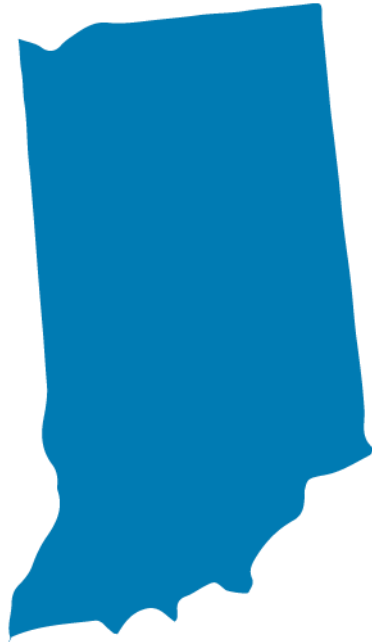
