Illinois Energy Code Compliance

Calling all Builders, Contractors, Code Officials, Cities, Architects, Designers, Engineers and Energy Experts!

Do you want to help ensure easier energy code compliance and improved common building practices in Illinois?

The Midwest Energy Efficiency Alliance (MEEA) is looking for new residential and commercial construction projects to participate in an anonymous survey of common building practices. Buildings will be observed during the construction phase to gain a better understanding of field implementation of energy code requirements.

This research project is funded by the Illinois electric and gas utilities, with some assistance from the U.S. Department of Energy, in order to provide support to the building industry and code officials with the residential and commercial building energy codes. A primary goal of this research is to identify missed opportunities for energy savings and potentially develop additional assistance programs to facilitate energy code compliance. No authority will be informed of any specific building's code compliance issues. Data will be anonymized and for many commercial buildings, collected in aggregate.
